Have you made sure you're registered to vote?

Did you know that if you're not registered to vote, you could have problems getting access to credit, opening a bank account or getting a mobile phone contract?



Being on the Register of Electors (the voters list) improves your credit rating.

If you're not listed on the Register, you might have problems getting access to financial services like:

- a loan
- a mobile phone contract
- a mortgage

Of course, being on the Register also means you can vote in elections in your area, choose who your local councillors are, and have your say on local issues.

We are now updating the Register of Electors for 2013/2014

A form like the one shown above will be delivered to your address around 25th October.

What do I need to do with the form?

If the information that is printed on your form is **correct** then you just need to confirm that everything is still the same. You can do this by:



- Telephone registration (free-phone)
- Online registration
- Text (SMS) registration



Details about these services are on the topright corner of your form

If the information printed on your form is **wrong**, you need to update it on the form and send the form back to us. Cross off the names of anyone who is listed on the form who doesn't live at your address anymore, and add any names that need to be listed. Make sure you sign the form before posting it back to us in the pre-paid envelope provided.
