### CHRISTMAS LIGHTS – SWITCH ON

Shortly after announcing news of this year's event during a committee meeting of Town Councillors on 7 August, Town Mayor Michael Ladd, gave *Connecting* the following statement:

SWITCH ON night in Southwold is a long established and enjoyable event and following the resignation of the previous hard-working Lights Committee, a partnership has risen out of the ashes. This partnership is between Southwold Town Council, Adnams and the Spring Design Agency.

The 2012 date is confirmed as Friday 7th December and is being project managed by Michael Ladd as Town Mayor with administrative support being provided by Adnams plc.

Due to the very short lead-time and level of funding available, it will, by necessity, be a much lower key event than in previous years, as we will need to 'cut our cloth accordingly'. Consequently we expect the event to be stripped down to the bare basics, but it will happen and will be very traditional in nature.

It is relatively early days, but we have had a good 'hand over' from the previous team and we are all confident that we can provide Southwold with an event to be proud of - much as we have already achieved this year with the Queen's Diamond Jubilee celebrations and the Olympic Torch relay.

More information will be forthcoming once we start finalising the details.
